


How to:

PARTY TENT PRINTABLE GUIDE

If the party that you are preparing is a significant size, you may find that it will be difficult to comfortably accommodate your guests in your home. The solution is to consider renting a party tent for your event. Determining the appropriate size of the tent or canopy to reserve is easy with this form. This printout will serve as a guide to help determine the size, spacing and layout for your canopy rental.




The most popular tent sizes are 30'x30' or 40'x40' (see diagrams below). However, on the second page, you will see that you can extend these lengths up to 100ft. We have also included cut out templates for tables, bars, dance floors and buffet lines for planning each detail of your event.

Feel free to cut and lay out these items inside your desired canopy square to create and design your space. Below is a key to identify the various items you can cut and paste onto your tent diagram. If you need an item which is not provided below, feel free to make your own, keeping within the (2cm=10 ft.) ratio.

6 ft. table by 30" wide that seats six persons comfortably.




4 ft. table by 30" wide that seats four persons comfortably.

Head table (8' x 30"), accommodating four persons.




This rectangular box is a buffet line 16' long (two 8' tables)

84" Serpentine table











